What is Geocaching?

Geocaching is a real-world, outdoor treasure hunting game using GPS-enabled devices. Participants navigate to a specific set of GPS coordinates and then attempt to find the geocache (container) hidden at that location.

How is the game played?

At its simplest level, geocaching requires these 8 steps:

- 1) Register for a free Basic Membership on Geocaching.com.
- 2) Visit the "Hide & Seek a Cache" page.
- 3) Enter your postal code and click "search."
- 4) Choose any geocache from the list and click on its name.
- 5) Enter the coordinates of the geocache into your GPS Device.
- 6) Use your GPS device to assist you in finding the hidden geocache.
- 7) Sign the logbook and return the geocache to its original location.
- 8) Share your geocaching stories and photos online.

What are the rules of Geocaching?

- 1) If you take something from the geocache (or "cache"), leave something of equal or greater value.
- 2) Write about your find in the cache logbook.
- 3) Log your experience at www.geocaching.com.
